## ECO- BHARAT: A SUSTAINABLE APPROACH FOR PRODUCING BIO-FUEL UTLIZING WITHERED FLOWER WASTE

The product is an advanced, **IoT** enabled anaerobic digester for producing bioenergy by anaerobic digestion of withered flower waste to produce biogas. Production of flower briquettes with the use of flower waste along with waste from Agro industries. The flower briquettes can be used as a fuel to generate heat on combustion and act as an energy source. The biogas and flower briquettes will find large application in cooking. With further refining & compression of the biogas, it can be used in vehicles and can also be converted into electrical energy.

#### The following are the highlights of the IQAC Meetings:

- 1. The committee has suggested applying for continuation of NBA accreditation to CSE, ISE ECE, EEE, Civil and Mechanical Engineering departments since the validity of NBA accreditations is valid up to 30<sup>th</sup> June 2024. The necessary applications were submitted, and an expert NBA team is scheduled to visit on 1<sup>st</sup> March 2024.
- 2. The committee had suggested to submit AQAR details to NAAC cycle 2 as a part of accreditation process. The details are being updated to the NAAC portal. The last date for updating the AQAR report is 29<sup>th</sup> February 2024
- 3. IQAC committee has recommend applying for QS I-Gauge Ranking Certification. The details as required for QS I-Gauge ranking has been prepared and the last for submission is 16<sup>th</sup> March 2024.
- 4. An international conference on "IEEE Distributed Computing & Optimization Techniques-(ICDCOT-2024)" and "Contemporary & sustainable infrastructure (ICCSI-2024)" is scheduled 15<sup>th</sup> & 16<sup>th</sup> of March 2024. The conferences are organised jointly by the Department of Electronics & Communication and Department of Electrical & electronics Engineering and department of Civil Engineering respectively.

ICDCOT-2024 has received over 1600 Research papers out of which around 200 papers have been selected for presentation and publishing in IEEE explorer.

ICCSI-2024 has received over 200 research papers out of which around 60 papers have been selected for presentation and publishing in IOP publisher.

Keynote address will be delivered by international expert from UK and from Institutes of National Importance in the country.
